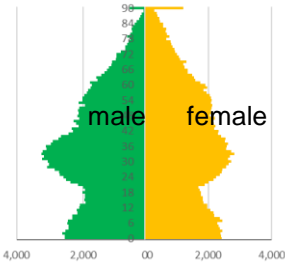


Equality in Brent

Protected characteristics

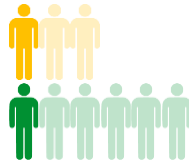
Age

36 is the average age of the population

Disability

14% of residents have a disability

Sexual orientation

4.6% of residents identify as Lesbian, Gay, or Bisexual

Young adults are 4 times more likely to identify as LGBT than their older counterparts

Other inequalities

599 families were prevented from becoming homeless in 2017;

OVER 12,000 HOUSEHOLDS ARE CURRENTLY IN NEED;

8.2% have no qualifications – higher than 6.8% - the London average;

Educational inequalities remain for Black Caribbean boys, looked-after children and care leavers;

89% of residents use the internet, 11% did not use the internet;
