Re: Results of the Public Consultation for Proposed Waiting and Loading Restrictions on the Bridgewater Road and Ealing Road (Between Bridgehill Close and Glacier Way)

I am writing to inform you of the outcome of the public consultation for the above proposals which closed on 10th May 2019. I would like to thank those of you that participated in the consultation and provided us with your views. The tables and analysis below summarises the outcome of the consultation

Question 1 - Do you agree with the proposed No Waiting 'at any time' restrictions?

Question 2 - Do you agree with the proposed No Loading 'at any time' restrictions?

Following consideration of all the responses that we received, a decision has been made to proceed with the implementation of this scheme with one amendment below:

- The proposed no waiting and no loading 'at any time' restrictions on the south western side of Bridgewater Road between Manor Farm Road and Bridgehill Close will not be progressed. The existing waiting and loading restrictions will therefore be retained on this section.

A report including the full results of the consultation, the decision made and the final scheme drawings will be available soon online at www.brent.gov.uk/consultation.

Arrangements of Traffic Management Orders (TMO) for the new restrictions will now be made, and it is anticipated that implementation of the scheme will commence in September 2019 and it is expected to take approximately 2 weeks to complete the work. The Council will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum and we apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be caused. The work will be carried out by the Council's term contractor.
