



**LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT  
THE BRENT (PARKING PLACES) (ZONE C) (NO. \*) ORDER 202\***

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above mentioned Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.
2. The general effect of the Parking Places Order would be to revoke a business permit parking place and re-designate it as a permit parking place that would operate between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive and between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and midnight on event days in the length of Ecclestone Place (the northern east to west arm), which lies on the north-west side, from a point 23.40 metres south-west of the north-western kerb-line of Wembley Hill Road south-westward for a distance of 8.50 metres.
3. Copy of the proposed Order, of the relevant parent Order of 2019 (and of any Orders which have amended that Order), of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and of maps which indicate each length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at Brent Customer Services, Brent Civic Centre, Engineers Way, Wembley, Middlesex, HA9 0FJ. **Please note:-** that we are unable to provide access to the council offices while coronavirus (COVID 19) social distancing measures are in place and the documents have been made available for inspection at <https://consultation.brent.gov.uk/highways-and-infrastructure/ecclestone-place-to-12-271-np>.
