The Brent (Parking Places) (Zone C) (No. *) Order 202*

The Council of the London Borough of Brent, after consulting the Chief of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Brent (Parking Places) (Zone C) (No. *) Order 202* and shall come into force on 202*.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order:
 - "Council" means the Council of the London Borough of Brent;
 - "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and
 - "the Order of 2019" means the Brent (Parking Places) (Zone C) (No. 1) Order 2019^b;
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2019 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Revocation of designation of parking places

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before coming into operation of this Order, the designation by the Order of 2019 of the parking place numbered 4 and set out in Schedule 6 therein, is hereby revoked.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2019 thereto

4. (1) Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and, unless otherwise so specified, having a width throughout of {1.83 metres} is designated as a parking place.
- (2) The provisions of the Order of 2019 (other than Articles 3 and 15) shall apply to the areas designated as parking places by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order, and any reference to Schedule 5 to the Order of 2019 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs {etc.}

5. The Council shall:
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order; and
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place traffic signs indicating that such parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4(1) and (2) of the Order of 2019;
 - (c) place and maintain traffic signs in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order indicating:-
 - (i) that the parking place may be used by vehicles making payment of the parking charge via the electronic payment system; and
 - (ii) the location identification number of the parking place or part thereof;
 - (d) install and maintain in proper working order pay and display machines in such positions as they think fit in the vicinity of certain parking places referred to in the Schedule to this Order; and}
 - (e) carry out such other work as is reasonably required by the Order of 2019 for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

SCHEDULE

PERMIT HOLDERS' PARKING PLACES (see Article 4)

In relation to a parking place described in this Schedule the expression "permitted hours" means either:-

- (1) the period between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday, a Bank Holiday or an event day; or
- (2) the period between 8.00 a.m. and midnight on an event day.

Parking places in which a vehicle may be left either:-

- (a) during the permitted hours on a day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday, a Bank Holiday or an event day without time limit, provided either: the vehicle displays a valid residents' permit or a valid business permit or a valid business address permit or a valid household visitor permit or a valid essential user permit or a valid school permit or a valid car club all zones permit, or in respect of which vehicle a valid residents' permit or a valid business permit or a valid visitor permit or a valid essential user permit or a valid school permit has been granted; or
- (b) during the permitted hours on an event day without time limit, provided either: the vehicle displays a valid residents' permit or a valid business permit or a valid business address permit or a valid household visitor permit or a valid essential user permit or a valid school permit or a valid car club all zones permit or a valid event day permit, or in respect of which vehicle a valid residents' permit or a valid business permit or a valid visitor permit or a valid essential user permit or a valid school permit or a valid event day permit has been granted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order revokes the designation of a certain parking place and re-designates a further parking place in Ecclestone Place in the London Borough of Brent and applies the provisions of the Order of 2019 to the parking places so designated.
