Proposed School Bus Parking scheme Manor School – Okehampton Road and Crediton Road

This document outlines our proposal to provide part-time School Bus Parking for Manor School, in Okehampton Road and Crediton Road.

Please read through the information provided and let us know what you think about the proposals by returning the enclosed questionnaire - **postage is free**. The document and plans of the improvements are also available online at www.brent.gov.uk/consultation. Only responses from within the consultation area will be considered. The consultation closes on **Friday 7 December 2018**.

Why are we proposing this change?

Brent Council has received numerous complaints from local residents and the school community regarding the lack of parking for school buses serving Manor School. Manor School is a primary special academy providing teaching for children with a range of special educational needs. At present, school buses often park in the middle of the road and at junctions. This causes congestion and can obstruct visibility for children, pedestrians and drivers of vehicles using the roads around the school. The current unsatisfactory parking conditions around the school constitute a significant health and safety risk for children, pedestrians and other road users.

What are the proposed improvements?


As shown on the attached drawing the proposed scheme includes:

- **Okehampton Road:** Proposed part time Bus Parking Bay to replace the existing School Keep Clear marking and approximately 4 car lengths of existing Resident Permit Holder bays. The Bus Parking Bay will be operational between 8.00 and 9.30am and between 2.30 and 4.00pm. Between 9.30am and 2.30pm the bays will be available for Resident Permit Holders. Between 4.00pm and 8.00am any vehicle will be able to park in the bay free of charge. The Bus Parking Bay will only be operational during school term times.
- **Crediton Road:** Proposed part time Bus Parking Bay to replace the existing Resident Permit Holder and Pay and Display parking bays. The Bus Parking Bay will be operational between 8.00 and 9.30am and between 2.30 and 4.00pm. Between 9.30am and 2.30pm and 4.00pm and 6.30pm the bays will be available for Resident Permit Holder and Pay and Display users. Between 6.30pm to 8.00am any vehicle will be able to park in the bay free of charge. The Bus Parking Bay will only be operational during school term times.
- The School Bus Parking Bays will be implemented on an experimental basis and the situation will be reviewed in 12 months when a further consultation will be undertaken to assess the effectiveness of the bays.
