



**LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT
THE BRENT (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 202***

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the 'Waiting and Loading Restriction' Order would be to further amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:-
 - (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
 - (b) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited in the times and in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice;
 - (c) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 40 minutes in the same place would be prohibited at the times and in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 1 and 2 inclusive to this Notice;
 - (d) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle would be prohibited (except on Sundays) in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 1 and 2 inclusive to this Notice, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
 - (e) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising would be prohibited in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 1 and 2 inclusive to this Notice;
 - (f) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any vehicle or animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 1 and 2 inclusive to this Notice would be revoked.
3. The prohibitions referred to in sub-paragraphs 2(a) to (c) inclusive above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" would apply.
4. A copy of the proposed Order, of the relevant Order of 1979 (and of any Orders which have amended that Order), of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order and of maps which indicate each length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order at Brent Customer Services, Brent Civic Centre, Engineers Way, Wembley, Middlesex, HA9 0FJ. **Please note:-** that we are unable to provide access to the council offices while coronavirus (COVID 19) social distancing measures are in place and the documents have been made available for inspection at <https://consultation.brent.gov.uk/highways-and-infrastructure/short-sections-to-02-272/np>. SCHEDULE 1

Waiting restrictions (At any time)

Clifford Road

- (a) the north-west and west sides, between 11 metres south-west of Bridgewater Road and 17.7 metres north of the boundary wall of the rear of Nos. 143 and 145 Bridgewater Road;
- (b) the south-east and east sides, between 28 metres south-west of Bridgewater Road and 11.5 metres north of the boundary wall of the rear of Nos. 143 and 145 Bridgewater Road;

Donnington Road - Kenton,

- (a) the north-east side, between 20 metres south-east of the Ilmington Road and 10.5 metres north-west of Ilmington Road;
- (b) the south-west side, between the common boundary of Nos. 55 and 57 Donnington Road and 8 metres south-east of that common boundary;

Fernleigh Court

- (a) the north-west side, between 10 metres south of Carlton Avenue East and 14.4 metres south of Carlton Avenue East;
- (b) the north-west side, between 33.4 metres south of Carlton Avenue East and 51.4 metres south of Carlton Avenue East;
- (c) the south-east side, between 10 metres south of Carlton Avenue East and 67.6 metres south of Carlton Avenue East;

Ilmington Road, between Donnington Road and 10.5 metres north-east of Donnington Road;

Malvern Road, the south-east side, between City of Westminster and Nos. 9 and 11 Malvern Road;

Roe Green

- (a) the north-west side, between 2 metres north-east of the south-western wall of No. 42 Roe Green and Nos. 50 and 52 Road Green;
- (b) the south-east side, between 3 metres north-east of Nos. 30 and 32 Road Green and Nos. 46 and 48 Road Green;

The Mall, the south-east side, between the boundary wall of Nos. 199 and 201 The Mall and the boundary wall of Nos. 201 and 203 The Mall.

SCHEDULE 2

Waiting restrictions (8 a.m. to 9 a.m. on Mondays to Fridays)

Clifford Road, the north-east side, between 10 metres south-west of Bridgewater Road and 28 metres south-west of Bridgewater Road;

Waiting restrictions (8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays)

Ferneigh Court

- (a) the north-west side, between 14.4 metres south of Carlton Avenue East and 33.4 metres south of Carlton Avenue East;
- (b) the north-west side, between 51.4 metres south of Carlton Avenue East and 77.7 metres south of Carlton Avenue East.
