



**LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT
THE BRENT (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 202*
THE BRENT (WEMBLEY STADIUM AREA) (PARKING PLACES) (NO. 1, 2012)
(AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 202***

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.
2. The general effect of the 'Waiting and Loading Restriction' Order would be to further amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:-
 - (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
 - (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 40 minutes in the same place would be prohibited at the times and in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
 - (c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle would be prohibited (except on Sundays) in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
 - (d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising would be prohibited in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
 - (e) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any vehicle or animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising in the lengths of streets specified in to this Notice would be revoked.
3. The prohibitions referred to in sub-paragraphs 2(a) and (b) inclusive above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" would apply.
4. The general effect of the Wembley Stadium area 'Parking Places Amendment' Order would be to revoke the existing event day permit parking places specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice in order to enable for the installation of bus stops in Windermere Avenue.
5. Please note that the speed table located outside Nos. 14-16 Windermere Avenue, Kenton is being removed.
6. A copy of the proposed Orders, of the relevant Order of 1979 (and of any Orders which have amended that Order), of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and of maps which indicate each length of road to which the Orders relate can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at Brent Customer Services, Brent Civic Centre, Engineers Way,

Wembley, Middlesex, HA9 0FJ. **Please note:** - that we are unable to provide access to the council offices while coronavirus (COVID 19) social distancing measures are in place and the documents have been made available for inspection at <https://consultation.brent.gov.uk/highways-and-infrastructure/traffic-order-to-02-268-np>. SCHEDULE 1

Waiting restrictions (At any time)

Windermere Avenue - Kenton, the south-east side, between Nos. 17 and 19 Windermere Court, Windermere Avenue and Nos. 21/22 and 23/24 Windermere Court, Windermere Avenue;

Windermere Avenue - Kenton, the south-east side, between 5.30 metres north-east of Nos. 7 and 9 Windermere Avenue and 5.30 metres south-west of Nos. 7 and 9 Windermere Avenue;

Windermere Avenue - Kenton, the south-east side, between 4.30 metres north-east of Nos. 15 and 17 Windermere Avenue and 2.70 metres south-west of Nos. 15 and 17 Windermere Avenue;

Windermere Avenue - Kenton, the north-west side, between Nos. 29 and 31 Windermere Court, Windermere Avenue Nos. 25/26 and 27/28 Windermere Court, Windermere Avenue;

Windermere Avenue - Kenton, the north-west side, between 2.20 metres north-east of Nos. 10 and 12 Windermere Avenue and 12.80 metres north-east Nos. 10 and 12 Windermere Avenue.

SCHEDULE 2

Revocation of Wembley Stadium Area parking places

Windermere Avenue, the north-west side, from 4.00 metres north-east of Nos. 8 and 10 Windermere Avenue north-eastward for a distance of 10.00 metres;

Windermere Avenue, the south-east side, from a point 8.50 metres north-east of Nos. 15 and 17 Windermere Avenue north-eastward for a distance of 7.00 metres.
