The Council of the London Borough of Brent, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by the Local Government Act 1985(b), the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986(c), the Parking Act 1989(d) and the Traffic Management Act 2004(e), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Brent (Wembley Stadium Area) (Parking Places) (No. 1, 2012) (Amendment No. 9) Order 2018 and shall come into operation for all purposes of Article 5 on * **** 202* and for all other purposes on * **** 202*.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order, "the Order of 2012" means the Brent (Wembley Stadium Area) (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 2012(f).
(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
(3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2012 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Revocation of designation of parking places

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2012 shall have effect as though the items in Schedule 1 to that Order numbered 1942 and 1947 were omitted.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2012 thereto

4. (1) Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and having a width throughout of 1.83 metres is designated as a parking place.
- (2) The provisions of the Order of 2012 (other than Articles 4 and 21) shall apply to the areas designated as parking places by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order, and any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2012 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs

5. The Council shall:
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place and of each parking space; and
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place traffic signs indicating that such parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Article 6 of the Order of 2012; and
 - (c) carry out such other work as is reasonably required by the Order of 2012 or by this Order for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place designated by this Order.

SCHEDULE (see Article 4)

In relation to a parking place described in this Schedule the expression "permitted hours" means the period between 10 a.m. and midnight on event days at Wembley National Stadium.
