THE BRENT (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. 3) TRAFFIC ORDER 2020

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Brent on 26th October 2020 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.
2. The general effect of the 'Disabled Persons Parking Places' Order will be to:-
 - (a) designate parking places in a certain length of the street specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period without charge;
 - (b) provide that the parking places will operate "at any time";
 - (c) specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge (commonly referred to as "the Blue Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 may be left therein;
 - (d) provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc;
 - (e) revoke the existing disabled parking place opposite the side of No. 193 Cricklewood Broadway, NW2 3HR.
3. The general effect of the 'Parking Places' Orders will be to reduce in length the existing shared-use parking places in Oaklands Road to enable for the relocation of disabled persons parking places specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.
4. The general effect of the 'Waiting and Loading Restriction' Order will be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:-
 - (a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice and between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice;
 - (b) waiting by vehicles (for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited at any time in the lengths of street specified in Schedule 4 to this Notice and between 7 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 5 to this Notice;
 - (c) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 40 minutes in the same place will be prohibited in the lengths of street specified in Schedules 2 and 3 inclusive to this Notice;
 - (d) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited (except on Sundays) in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 2 to 5 inclusive to this Notice, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
 - (e) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising will be prohibited in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 2 to 5 inclusive to this Notice;

- (f) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any vehicle or animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 2 to 5 inclusive to this Notice will be revoked.
5. The prohibitions referred to in sub-paragraphs 4(a) to (c) inclusive above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue Badge" will apply.
 6. The general effect of the 'Prescribed Route' Order will be to prohibit vehicles from entering that length of Oaklands Road, which lies between its junction with Cricklewood Broadway and a point 27.00 metres south-west of that junction.
 7. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 6 above will not apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a pedal cycle.
 8. A copy of the proposed Orders, which will come into force on 9th November 2020, and of maps which indicate each length of road to which the Orders relates can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made at Brent Customer Services, Brent Civic Centre, Engineers Way, Wembley, Middlesex, HA9 0FJ. **Please note:** - that we are unable to provide access to the council offices while coronavirus (COVID 19) social distancing measures are in place and the documents have been made available for inspection at <https://consultation.brent.gov.uk/highways-and-infrastructure/traffic-order-to-25-085-np>. Any person desiring to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE 1

Disabled Parking Bay on carriageway in

Oaklands Road, the south-east side, from 2.5 metres south-west of the north-eastern wall of No. 2 Oaklands Road to 9.10 metres south-west of that wall.

SCHEDULE 2

Waiting restrictions (At any time)

Cricklewood Broadway, the south-west side, between the north-western wall of No. 191 Cricklewood Broadway and 7.8 metres north-west of that wall;

Cricklewood Broadway, the south-west side, between 3.2 metres the south-east of north-western wall of No. 191 Cricklewood Broadway and 20.2 metres south-east of that wall;

Oaklands Passage, between Oaklands Road and 2.5 metres south-west of Oaklands Road;

Oaklands Road, the north-west side, between the north-easternmost extremity of Oaklands Road and 7.20 metres south-west of that extremity;

Oaklands Road, the south-east side, between 3.50 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Oaklands Passage and the north-easternmost extremity of Oaklands Road;

SCHEDULE 3

Waiting restrictions (7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays)

Cricklewood Broadway, the south-west side, between 4.1 metres south-east of the south-eastern wall of No. 193 Cricklewood Broadway and 3.3 metres north-west of that wall;

SCHEDULE 4

Loading Restrictions (At any time)

Cricklewood Broadway, the south-west side, between the north-western wall of No. 191 Cricklewood Broadway and 7.8 metres north-west of that wall;

Oaklands Passage, between Oaklands Road and 2.5 metres south-west of Oaklands Road;

Oaklands Road, the north-west side, between the north-easternmost extremity of Oaklands Road and 7.20 metres south-west of that extremity;

Oaklands Road, the south-east side, between 3.50 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Oaklands Passage and the north-easternmost extremity of Oaklands Road;

SCHEDULE 5

Loading Restrictions (7 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays)

Cricklewood Broadway, the south-west side, between the south-eastern wall of No. 193 Cricklewood Broadway and 4.4 metres south-east of that wall.
