TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

2020 No. 182

The Brent (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 6) Order 2020

Made: 26th October 2020

Coming into force: 9th November 2020

The Council of the London Borough of Brent, after consulting the Chief of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Brent (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 5) Order 2020 and shall come into force on 9th November 2020.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order:
"Council" means the Council of the London Borough of Brent;
"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and
"the Order of 2001" means the Brent (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2001^b;
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2001 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Revocation of designation of parking places

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before coming into operation of this Order the designation by the Order of 2001 of the parking place numbered 74 and set out in the Schedule therein, is hereby revoked.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2001 thereto

4. (1) Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and, unless otherwise so specified, having a width throughout of {1.83 metres} is designated as a parking place.
- (2) The provisions of the Order of 2001 (other than Articles 3 and 15) shall apply to the areas designated as parking places by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order, and any reference to the Schedule to the Order of 2001 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs {etc.}

5. The Council shall place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place and that each parking place may only be used by vehicles specified in Article 5 of the Order of 2001

AREAS ON STREETS DESIGNATED AS PARKING PLACES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

The Brent (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 2001 designates parking places in the London Borough of Brent in which a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000 may be left. The provisions of the Order of 2001 are applied to other similarly designated parking places within that Borough.

This Order designates a parking place in Oaklands Road and applies the provisions of the Order of 2001 to the parking place so designated.

This Order also revokes the disabled person's parking place in Oaklands Road designated by the Order of 2001, as amended.
